Crowing a 'green manure' is an easy and effective way to add vital organic matter to the soil anywhere in your garden or allotment. The foliage helps to suppress weeds and provides cover for beetles and other pest-eating creatures. The roots will help improve your soil structure. When the green manure plants are dug back into the soil they decay to release their nutrients for whatever you plant next.

Plant green manures into your vegetable crop rotation; grow them anywhere the soil would otherwise be left empty for six weeks or longer. You can still use green manures with a 'No Dig' system. Plants can be hoed off or killed with a mulch. Autumn sown, frost tender varieties are killed off over winter, leaving a protective cover of dead foliage.



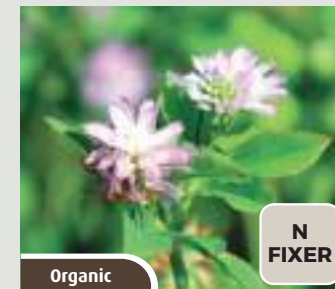

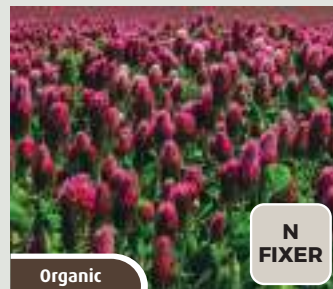
