## Before using the equipment

- ALWAYS use due care and attention when assembling the tool!
- Keep face/head/arms/hands away from the bar while operating the unit.
- Keep children and bystanders a safe distance away from unit while operating.

## Assembly

- Take out storage clip, then slowly release pressure. The bar will rise 5cm (2 in) (Fig 1).
- Install feet then re-install storage clip (Fig 2).
- Press down foot pedal and re-clip storage clip (Fig 3).
- Turn height adjuster 2 to 3 times anti-clockwise (Fig 4).
- Undo storage clip then re-clip after bar is up (Fig 5).
- Adjust foot pedal height to at least 33cm (13 in). The unit is now ready to use (Fig 6).

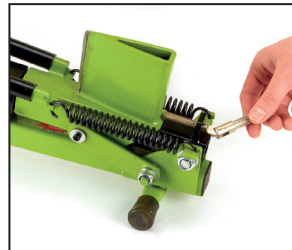

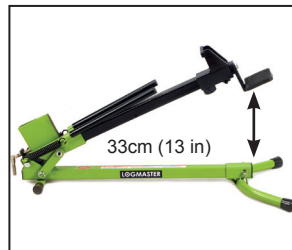

## Getting Started

### Operation

- Place the Log Splitter on a level, even surface. Non-slip matting may be used to protect the floor area (Fig 1).
- Step on the foot pedal and push down using firm pressure then step down and repeat – it may take 3 to 4 attempts to split an average log (Fig 2).
- Place foot on the lower bar, pull back the slide stop first (lift up on lever) and pull the log out sideways (Fig 3). Your log is split and ready for use (Fig 4).
- Maintain good balance while operating unit. If needed, hold onto something stable while stepping down on pedal.
- NOTE: This Log Splitter is to be used on the floor in a horizontal position. Improper use will create risk of injury.

### Tips

- Wet or non seasoned wood is more difficult to split than dry wood because the fibres stick together. Reversing the block and splitting from the other end may help if you cannot pull the wood apart.
- Similarly large or multiple knots in a log make splitting more difficult. Usually if the log is rotated so that the knots are vertical to the blade, the wood will split more easily and less stress is placed on the splitter. This will reduce wear and tear or possibility of damaging some component of the splitter.

### Care

- To keep unit clean and operating smoothly, keep moving parts lubricated with an anti-rust machine oil.
